Site Emergency handling

Police fire and ambulance Call 911

Site location: NW 5-33-3-w3m, GPS location 51.807043,-106.395357

Directions: From Dundurn travel East10km on paved secondary 211 to the East side of Lake Blackstrap and follow due East across the causeway and continue East to the top of the lake valley to the first road heading north(left). Turn North and follow the road 1.7 km to the first trail on the left, just prior to the gravel pit on the left marked BSSC. This is the club entrance and follow down the hill to the parking lot.

For all Medical Emergencies:

- 1. Assess the situation and ensure your own safety.
- 2. Determine number of and severity of injured. Prevent any further injuries.
- 3. Phone 911 or have someone phone 911 and get back to you to confirm help is on the way- stay with the injured if possible.
- 4. If the injured is on the water and cannot get back only enter the water if you have enough support to do so and can return with the injured safely. If their life is not in danger, wait for emergency crews to arrive before leaving shore and get the safety boat prepared.
- 5. The first aid book and first aid kit is in the clubhouse.
- 6. Continue to stay with the injured until emergency crews have arrived. Hand off all pertinent information and assist as necessary.

For all Fire Emergencies

- 1. Assess the situation and ensure you own safety.
- 2. If the fire is small and you feel comfortable to do so and are trained in handing a fire extinguisher, try to put out the fire. Then call 911.
- 3. if you are not sure you can get the small fire out with the extinguisher call 911 immediately and keep back.
- 4. Fuel related fires are difficult to control and should be handled by emergency crews.
- 5. Wait in a safe area for emergency crews to arrive.

For all Police Emergencies

- 1. Assess the situation and ensure your own safety.
- 2. Call 911 immediately and try to record details of the incident on paper.
- 3. Wait for emergency crews to arrive.
